RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

During this term we will introduce our whole-school theme, "Knowing and Growing as Stewards of God's Creation." We will focus on inclusion and also complete a unit on Lent & Easter.

INTEGRATED

This term we will be exploring the concept of Harmony and using this as a learning lens to look break open science, history and geography. Our 'Keys for learning' will play a vital role in our integrated learning.

We will use digital technologies to enhance our learning through research and creatively discover ways to present our understandings using a variety of apps and undertaking bootcamp sessions to ensure safe use.

HOMEWORK

Continuing on from the success of Passion Projects last year in 5/6, students will be asked to complete a Passion Project each term. Students will choose an area (or topic) they would like to learn more about, then spend 6 weeks researching and compiling a presentation in their chosen area, before presenting their work to their peers in Weeks 9/10. It is also expected that students spend at least 20 minutes reading each evening.

A Seesaw account will be provided for additional Maths homework support.

Library, Indonesian, Art, Sustainability

(Mondays)

On Mondays, students will undertake two 1 hour sessions in Llbrary and Art. On Thursdays, students will learn Indonesian language skills for 30 minutes.

Students will have integrated sessions in the greenhouse to explore sustainability.

CAMP

Students will attend the Birrigai camp in week 7. This will have a heavy curriculum focus on the Gold Rush and allow the children the opportunity to gain vital background knowledge for their assignment work.

ENGLISH

Our Literacy Blocks will incorporate a range of different teaching strategies, student-teacher conferencing, modelled reading and writing strategies, comprehension, literacy rotations and handwriting.

Each week will see a focus on a different reading or writing strategy based upon class needs.

We will be using the Sounds Write program to explicitly focus on decoding spelling for students.
